My dear Professor Boas,

I am taking the liberty of enclosing translation of an excerpt from the Voelkischer Beobachter although I hesitated for quite a while whether I should bring this vile piece of scribbling to your attention. However, the Nazi propaganda service has made such wide use of it that I thought it best to let you know about it.

Since I had the pleasure of seeing you three months ago when I gave you detailed information on Nazi organizations in this country I have been busy - literally day and night - gathering new information. The result is really quite alarming. Knowing how interested you are in these matters I shall be glad to visit you again for another chat if you desire.
